Audition Information

Application:

Prior to attending the audition, you must have a complete application on file. Applications for the 2010-2011 school year are due April 2, 2010 by 4pm. Students will not be permitted to audition without a completed application.

Audition Dates and Times:

Auditions will be held May 8.. You will receive a check in letter upon the receipt of your completed application. Check in for auditions begins at 8:30am. Please plan to stay for approximately six hours.

The Audition:

Auditions will be held in the one of the two dance studios at A. B. Miller High School. Applicants will participate in a class which will include a ballet barre, adagio and petit allegro; modern center, traveling and elevation; and a short jazz combination. The purpose of the audition class is to demonstrate the applicant's technical ability in a variety of dance styles and his/her ability to take direction. The conservatory is looking for talent and potential as a performer. The faculty is most interested in those students who show strong performing abilities, an openness to assimilate corrections, and a willingness to learn in the various styles.

What to Wear:

Applicants are required to wear appropriate dance attire for the audition. Please DO NOT wear leg warmers, sweaters, or jewelry. **MEN: BLACK** tights or jazz pants, white t-shirt and ballet shoes. **WOMEN: BLACK** leotard, black or pink tights (that can be rolled up for modern dance), and ballet shoes.

For the modern dance selection, applicants must be barefoot. For the jazz section, applicants may wear jazz shoes.

Notification:

Acceptance letters will be mailed June 5. Notification letters or emails will give detailed information about your enrollment in the Conservatory. Students who do not receive a notification letter or email may call the Conservatory Office after June 31.
